

Error 3001

An Error 3001 typically occurs when exporting data to formats other than the Remark (RMK/RMX) format. The problem is usually due to the region names that are defined in the template. Export formats have certain restrictions (see the Remark Office OMR User's Guide by clicking Help|Documentation in the software for more complete information). You should check your region names for illegal characters, such as symbols ,'+ brackets [] parentheses () dashes - etc. Try using letters, numbers, spaces and underscores instead. Region name length can also cause an Error 3001. For example, when saving to the Excel and Access formats, you are limited to 64 characters in your region names.
